These “outside of the classroom” learning opportunities offered by the department ranges from various modules to the volunteerism events and expert lectures hosted in conjunction with other faculties or institutions.

Happy to share with you all that we have increase the intake of B.Pharm to 100 seats and also introducing Diploma in Pharmacy 60 seats in the session 2021-2022. Increase uptake has been approved by PCI, AICTE and RGPV University from its end. The department has recently established more sophisticated laboratories equipped with instruments and glassware’s such as: Pharmaceutical Microbiology, Pharmaceutics (Dosage form development), Pharmacology and Pharmaceutical Chemistry (Drug Synthesis lab).

Due to COVID-19 pandemic we are imparting continuous education to the students through virtual mode using Microsoft team’s platform. Pharmacy students have actively participated and presented innovative working models and poster in SRIJAN 2020. Two pharmacy teams were selected and presented their innovative working model at state level. Our Department has organized ‘Quizzi Pharm’ National level Quiz Competition on the occasion of “National Science Day” on 28th Feb 2021 in which large number of participants from different states of India has participated.

Both the faculties have received a sum of 10000/- scholarship for future research work. 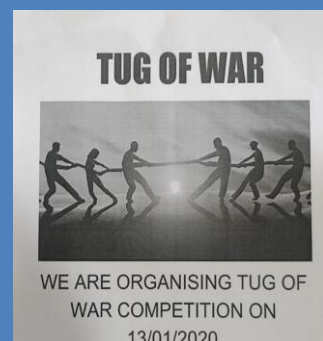
World Pharmacist Day
